Since becoming a Roost in 1999, we have worked hard to raise money for various entities, just like all Roosts do. We have worked annually to help the House of Ruth, the Paralyzed Veterans of America, and many other causes local, national, and international.

We work closely with St. Vincent's Children Center in Timonium (as other Roosts do) where over 70 abused children ages 4-14 are housed, cared for, and educated. We have an annual picnic for the kids, repair or replace athletic equipment, and buy school supplies.

Our Foundation purchases and delivers over 200 meals at Thanksgiving to families in our community who would otherwise go without. We also have started assisting a shelter at Christmas, delivering supplies and manpower.

Each January many of our members have joined other Roosts in the Polar Bear Plunge raising money for Special Olympics Maryland. It's one more chance to tailgate with our favorite Ravens fans and have a great time while helping a great cause!
